## Resident Police Officer Program

In an effort to increase the public safety presence in its developments and to improve the quality of life for its residents, the Chelsea Housing Authority (“CHA”) has developed the *Resident Police Officer Program*.

As such, only current police officers of the Chelsea Police Department are eligible to participate in the *Resident Police Officer Program* with the CHA.

All selected Police Officers must read and sign an acknowledgement of the policies of the *Resident Officer Program*.

All selected Police Officers must sign a License Agreement with the CHA for the use and occupancy of the apartment.

Effective July 1, 2012, the *Resident Police Officer Program* will consist of five (5) Resident Police Officers.

### Development Assignments

**Prattville and Fitzpatrick Developments:** One (1) Police Officer will live at either Prattville or Fitzpatrick development in a two-bedroom apartment. The Officer will be assigned to both Prattville and Fitzpatrick developments and will be responsible for the duties as delineated in the resident officer policies and license agreement.

**Innes Development:** One (1) Police Officer will live at the Innes development in a two-bedroom apartment. The Officer will be assigned to the Innes development and will be responsible for the duties as delineated in the resident officer policies and license agreement.

**Buckley and Union Park Developments:** One (1) Police Officer will live at the Buckley building in a one-bedroom apartment. The Officer will be assigned to both the Buckley building and Union Park developments and will be responsible for the duties as delineated in the resident officer policies and the license agreement.

**Scrivano Development:** One (1) Police Officer will live at the Scrivano development in a two-bedroom apartment. The Officer will be assigned to the Scrivano development and the Main Offices at 54 Locke Street and will be responsible for the duties as delineated in the resident officer policies and agreements.

**Margolis and Mace Developments:** One (1) Police Officer will live at the Margolis building in a one-bedroom apartment. The Officer will be assigned to both the Margolis and Mace developments and will be responsible for the duties as delineated in the resident officer policies and license agreements.
